# What is the "Hiroshima International Plaza's Global Relations Program" (GRP)?

# [Outline]

This program is for international students who can move into the "Hiroshima International Plaza (HIP)" and acquire the "practical skills" to play an active role in the global community while attending their university.

The purpose of the program is to provide international students assistance in addition to support for research activities and work from the university, by creating a living environment where they can have various experiences other than studying, and cultivate the following:

- · An understanding of Japanese language and culture
- · The abilities required to be a global citizen and a leader of the next generation
- · A spirit of seeking multicultural coexistence, collaboration, and peace

### [Capacity]

19 rooms (1 person each)

Space:17 m<sup>2</sup>

#### [Facilities]

Each room comes with:

An air conditioner, bathroom (toilet, bathtub, sink), television, refrigerator, bed, chair, desk with light, shelf, closet, futon, curtain, shoe rack

• Shared use on the 4<sup>th</sup> floor:

Hot water dispenser, ice machine, laundry machine, microwave, ironing board, refrigerator, freezer, cookware

• Cooking room:

Other than on the day of an event or rental, the cooking room is open for use every day.

- Free Wi-Fi
- Restaurant (1F) (open every day all year)
- Clinic (1F)
- Gymnasium, field, tennis court
- To commute from the HIP to Hiroshima University

Free JICA bus (weekdays only/twice in the morning, once in the evening)

Shared taxi (220 yen/ride, Mondays through Fridays, pickup times specified)

### [Rent]

Monthly rent 27,860 yen ~ 30,470 yen (daily rent 870 yen)

\*Administrative costs 3,500 yen/month and Utility costs (power and water) are included.

## [Rental period]

One year in principle (in the case of an exception, max 2 years)

#### [Recruitment]

< i >International students who attend universities in Hiroshima Prefecture.

(Global Skills Development Course)

< ii > Students overseas or in a different prefecture who will enroll in a university in Hiroshima Prefecture. (Foundation for Everyday Life Course)

# [Qualifications to apply] (Must fulfill all of the following)

- 1 Those who are enrolled in a university (including graduate school) in Hiroshima Prefecture and will continue to be enrolled for the next 3 months or more;
- 2 Those who have been recommended by their school;
- 3 Those who are able to participate in the Hiroshima International Center's training program, etc.;
- 4 Those who are willing to participate in events organized by the Hiroshima International Center;
- 5 Those who value international exchange and can live in harmony with other residents.

# [Application period, capacity]

Twice a year in principle (we will recruit new residents based on vacancies via the university secretariat during spring and autumn admission)
