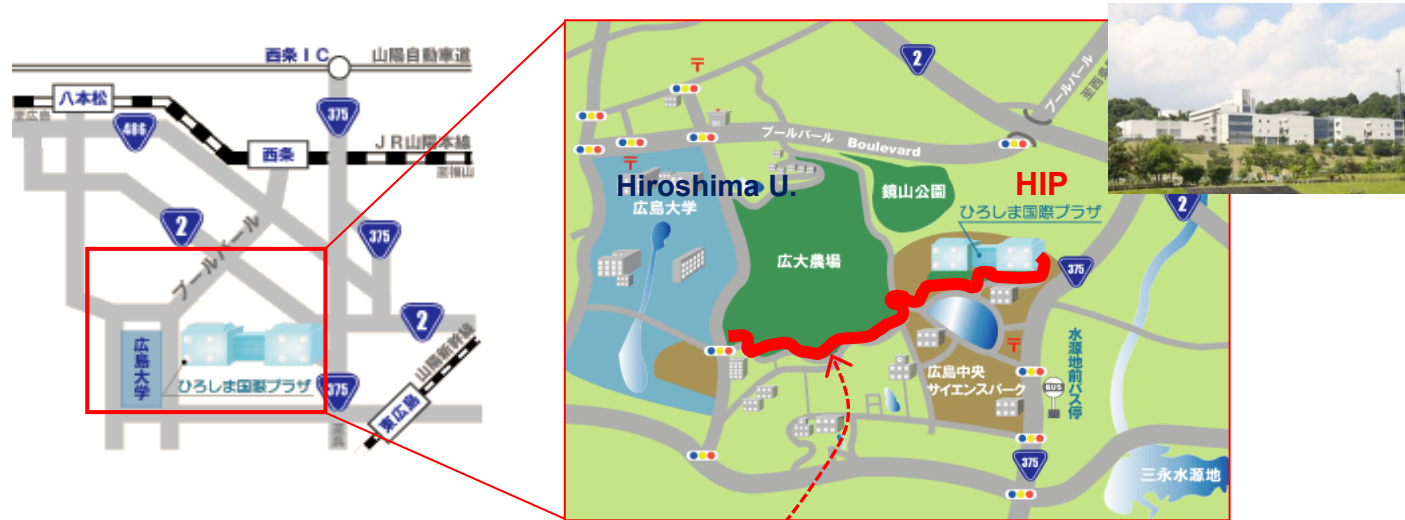
Hiroshima International Plaza's "Global Relations Program"

Application details for a long-term stay at the Hiroshima International Plaza.

This program is geared towards providing an environment where international students can acquire the "practical skills" they need to play an active roll in the global community while living at the Plaza and going to school.

After moving in,

- You can participate in the Japanese cultural experiences held in the Plaza.
- You will be able to get valuable experience by taking part in voluntary activities and helping out with events
- Japanese teachers will be available to advise your Japanese study.



The HIP is 2.5 km from Hiroshima University. The JICA free bus goes through the university on weekdays. (2 services in the mornings and 1 service in the evenings.) Shared taxi service is available for GRP Trainees. (¥220 per use / Weekdays/fixed times only.)

★Rental Period:

One year in principle (although we may allow for up to two years)

★Rent:

Daily rent ¥800 administrative costs ¥2,550/month

★For a single person Space:17m²

★About the Facilities:

- * Each room comes with an air conditioner, bathroom, television, refrigerator, bed, desk, chair, bookshelf, closet, desk lamp, futon, curtain, shoebox
- * Wi-Fi is available.
- * Shared use: hot water dispenser, ice machine, laundry machine, microwave, ironing board, refrigerator, freezer, cookware.

Other than an event or rental date, the cooking room can be used daily.

Global Skills Development Course

In order to support the future employment and research activities for the international students in Hiroshima, we will provide the students with a comfortable environment where they further their studies and can gain various life experiences in order to cultivate the following competencies:

Qualifications

International Students who:

- (1) attend universities in Hiroshima Prefecture (undergraduate/graduate levels) & study here for more than three months;
- (2) have a letter of recommendation from their school;
- (3) are able to participate in the Hiroshima international Center's training program;
- (4) are willing to participate in events organized by the Hiroshima International Center;
- (5) understand international exchange and can live in harmony with other residents.
